Alcohol Policy

As a “Wet County”, there is a “No Limit” issue to the amount of Alcohol that customers for a BYOB Event can bring into the Civic Center.

The customer can designate a person, of their own discretion, to pass out or pour alcohol if they wish; or they may stockpile the alcohol, allowing each person to get their own. However, doing any of this, it will be the responsibility of the **Contracted Customer and/or the Designated Server** for the Amount of consumption that is given or supplied to the guest, and **Not** the responsibility of the Civic Center’s for any liability issues.

Absolutely **NO SELLING** of any alcohol will be allowed at any BYOB event.

Absolutely **NO ALCOHOL WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES AT ANY EVENT HONORING A MINOR.** Any violation of this rule will result in immediate shut down of the event and forfeiture of all payments paid and due.

Alcoholic beverages can only be served to individuals **21 years of age or older** and at no time shall a minor be served alcoholic beverages. Any violation of this rule (State Law) there will be an immediate shut down, loss of payments paid or due, and Lawful action will be taken.

If there appears to be any misrepresentation by the renter as to the number of people or type of event taking place, the event will be terminated. Again, loss of any paid or due finances will be forfeited.

It will be to the discretion of the Civic Center Director to determine the need for security and/or the amount of officers needed for any event serving Alcohol. The number of Officers shall be one (1) for every 100 attendees. Security will require 30 minutes prior to start of event and will conclude after events ends. Officers will work a minimum of 4 hours.
